Dhonakulhi Island, Maldives - 17th October 2009

The Meridis Dive Team at the Island Hideaway at Dhonakulhi Maldives, Spa Resort & Marina participated in the 350 event, held yesterday. Around the same time as the first-ever Underwater cabinet meeting, that was held yesterday, the team undertook a dive in the Dhonakulhi Lagoon and the entire diving team held the message **“Reduce CO2 emission below 350ppm”**, whereby endorsing their participation in the event.

It is the primary objective of the entire Dive Team at Dhonakulhi to reduce all their carbon emissions below the 350ppm ambitious benchmark, that has been set by the Government of Maldives as one of their critical goals, for all industries within the Maldives.

The Maldives working Cabinet, held a meeting underwater, in an effort to focus on the climate changes which is affecting the low lying nation – Maldives. Maldives is just about 2 metres above sea level. The meeting was the first of its kind in the world, and was held to send a message to the world and to the upcoming UN climate summit in Copenhagen in December'09.
